- For assessment of students of Balvatika classes (KVs where Balvatika class/es opened), guidelines given in 'The Preschool Curriculum' by NCERT, Chapter-6 (Page 54-56) needs to be followed. Further, the guidelines outlined in the National Curriculum Framework for Foundational Stage (NCF FS/SE), Chapter-6 Assessment for Further learning (Page 169-184) are also to be followed for Balvatika classes.
- The individual progress of children of Class I, II, III to attain the learning outcomes in line with **NIPUN BHARAT Mission** to be recorded month wise by the subject teachers.
- The dates mentioned for assessments/test are tentative and a little deviation may be done by the Vidyalayas as per the suitability.
- The number of **Learner Achievement Test (LAT)** prescribed is for indicative purpose only. The subject teachers can conduct more number LATs as based upon the learning outcomes to be attained.
- **MDP, Notebook, Portfolio, ASL, Projects & Subject enrichment activities as well as AIL (Art integrated Learning)** should be planned judiciously in subject committee meeting and in collaboration with the subject teachers of other subjects of the respective class. It should be based on the guidelines of NEP 2020.
- In Class-I and II, out of 9 cycle tests the best 8 cycle tests to be taken into consideration and will be reflected in report card.
- Classes VI to VIII learner's diary (Reflective Practices) should be ensured in each subject on regular basis.
- Split-Up Syllabus prescribed by KVS and CBSE are to be strictly followed to ensure timely completion of syllabus. For the time being Split-up of the last session to be followed.
- Ten days Pre-vocational training for students of Classes VI to VIII to be completed by December, 2024.
- All KVs should allot Artificial Intelligence (AI) as Skill Subject in Classes IX & X to all students.
- Syllabus for Classes X & XII to be completed by 10th November, 2024 positively.
- Curriculum document released by CBSE for the Academic Session 2024-25 and the Sample Question Papers may also be referred to for details of the QP design of individual subjects.
